## ATTENTION STARFLEET COMMAND

**You are now holding the official Mission Orders for your upcoming voyage. This essential packet provides everything you need to maximize your cruise experience.**

Onboard *Star Trek: The Cruise*, you are more than just a passenger — you are an integral part of the crew! Nowhere else in this universe or beyond offers nonstop *Star Trek* fun with unforgettable, unique moments.

So, set your phasers to fun and brace yourself for an interstellar journey unlike any other this side of the Delta Quadrant!

**Please carefully review this information in its entirety, even if you have previously sailed with Entertainment Cruise Productions, as some processes and procedures may have changed.**



### CHECK OUT MY ROYAL CRUISE

My Royal Cruise is Royal Caribbean's Pre-Cruise Planner, the place to plan your cruise while getting the most out of your travel adventure. Securing reservations and purchasing cruise package deals before you sail lets you score the best savings. From drinks to specialty dining to internet and spa services, check out all Royal Caribbean has to offer so you can save big NOW. ### LOCATE YOUR PASSPORT

Just like the crew of the *USS Voyager* wouldn't leave the dock without their command codes, you wouldn't try to board our starship at sea without a passport! Once located, check the expiration date. Your passport should have an expiration date of September 2, 2025, OR LATER (6 months AFTER the cruise sails). We highly recommend that all guests travel with a passport, but if you are a US Citizen and do not possess a passport, you may travel with an original birth certificate and valid state ID.

**IMPORTANT!** The original birth certificate must include a raised seal and the name on the state ID must match the birth certificate. Non-US Citizens should verify the required documentation by visiting the Booked Guests Portal on [StarTrekTheCruise.com](https://www.StarTrekTheCruise.com).

### PURCHASE TRAVEL INSURANCE

Imagine you're aboard the *USS Voyager* on a mission to locate your undercover Security Chief. One minute, you're navigating the Badlands, and the next, you're caught in polarized magnetic variation, being hurled light-years off course. Whether you're infiltrating a Borg cube, escaping a Kazon ambush, or racing temporal anomalies, space is unpredictable!

That's why you need Travel Insurance. Well, not really, but we strongly encourage the purchase of Travel Insurance in case something goes wrong. All payments made for a Reservation are non-refundable at the time of payment. Though insurance may be purchased up to 48 hours prior to sailing, to secure the broadest coverage, including pre-existing conditions, Travel Insurance should be purchased as early as possible. ### GETTING TO MIAMI, FLORIDA

Unless you reside near Miami, FL, we recommend guests arrive in the area at least one day prior to embarkation day.

Once you arrive in Miami, FL, you will be responsible for arranging transportation to the Port of Miami. Uber, Lyft, and taxi services are readily available and offer affordable transportation from nearby airports and/or hotels.

Boarding on February 23, 2025, typically begins around 11:00 AM ET, and all guests must be onboard no later than 3:00 PM ET.

45 Days prior to the cruise (January 9, 2025), you will receive email instructions on how to complete the required Online Check-In. At that time, you will select a Terminal Arrival Time. **DO NOT ARRIVE TO THE TERMINAL BEFORE YOUR SELECTED ARRIVAL TIME.**

### GETTING HOME

Once the ship arrives back to Miami on March 2, 2025, Customs and Border Patrol will perform an inspection. After the ship has been cleared, you will be allowed to disembark.

Due to the time it takes to clear the ship, we recommend booking return flights after 12:00 PM ET on disembarkation day.

Uber, Lyft, and taxi services are readily available and offer affordable transportation to nearby airports.

# ONBOARD EXPERIENCE

From the moment you step onboard, we surround your senses with *Star Trek* by providing you with moments you can see, hear, touch, and taste!

From one-of-a-kind shows, interactive events, Q&As, panel discussions, trivia sessions, and karaoke to nightly themed parties, each day and night is jam-packed with excitement.

Inside your cabin you'll find your Royal Caribbean SeaPass Card. It is important to keep this SeaPass Card with you throughout the week.

Royal Caribbean's SeaPass Card is a multifunctional card that serves many purposes including your cabin key, charge card for onboard purchases, entry into each night's show in the Main Theater, and boarding pass for identification checking in and out of port.

Your SeaPass Card will either be **BLUE** or **RED**. When you made your reservation, you selected to attend the early/1st Main Show or the late/2nd Main Show each evening. Guests who selected the 1st Main Show will have **Blue SeaPass Cards**, and guests who selected the 2nd Main Show will have **Red SeaPass Cards**. **REST ASSURED** – Guests with **RED SeaPass Cards** WILL NOT be subject to the infamous "Red Shirt" treatment.

Guests with **BLUE SeaPass Cards** will attend the 1st Main Show (starting around 6:30 PM) and guests with **RED SeaPass Cards** will attend the 2nd Main Show (starting around 9:00 PM). Guests are required to adhere to their Main Show Time and will NOT be allowed into other shows. SeaPass Cards will be checked prior to entering the Main Theater. All other shows and venues are first come, first served, unless indicated.

## ONLINE CHECK IN & LUGGAGE TAGS

**45 Days** prior to the cruise you will receive instructions on how to complete Royal Caribbean's Online Check-In. Once your online check-in is complete, you can print your Set Sail Pass, which acts as your boarding pass for Embarkation Day. Guests who do not complete their online check-in will incur a substantial delay at the terminal on Embarkation Day.

**30 Days** prior to the cruise you will receive instructions on how to print your Royal Caribbean Luggage Tags. These tags should be affixed to your luggage the morning of embarkation. Additional details will be provided as we approach these dates.

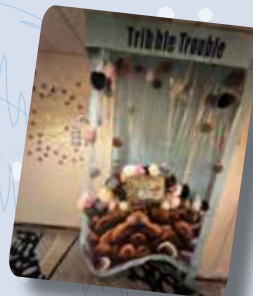


## CABIN DOOR DECORATING CONTEST
