

ONCE ONBOARD

Once you board our starship at sea, feel free to explore, hang by the pool or grab a beverage of your choice! Your cabin will be available to you around 2:00 PM ET. Inside your cabin, you will find your Royal Caribbean SeaPass Card. The SeaPass Card serves many purposes including your cabin key, charge card for onboard purchases, entry into the Lyric Theatre, and boarding pass for entering and exiting the ship in various ports of call. It is important to keep your SeaPass Card with you throughout the week.

Each night the Lyric Theatre takes the spotlight where you can catch some of the incredible Trek-centric shows and performances. Due to theatre capacity, some shows are split into two viewings, based on SeaPass Card color. Having two show times each night allows all guests the opportunity to see every performance. Guests with **BLUE SeaPass Cards** will attend the 1st Main Show (starting around 6:30 PM) and guests with **RED SeaPass Cards** will attend the 2nd Main Show (starting around 9:00 PM). You will be required to adhere to your Main Show time and will NOT be allowed into other shows. SeaPass Cards will be checked prior to entering the Lyric Theatre. All other shows and performances are open seating, unless otherwise indicated.


PROMENADE VIEW WINDOW DECORATING CONTEST

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PREPARING FOR YOUR VOYAGE

LOCATE YOUR PASSPORT!

Think of your passport as your Starfleet ID. Without it, you can't beam down to new planets, explore the far reaches of Earth's galaxy, or board the ship on Embarkation Day! Locate your Passport NOW and make sure the expiration date is not before August 27, 2026, that's 6 months AFTER our sailing. If you are a US Citizen and do not have a passport, you may travel with an original birth certificate and valid state ID. PLEASE NOTE—the original birth certificate must include a raised seal and the name on the state ID must match the birth certificate. Non-US Citizens should verify the required documentation by visiting the **Booked Guests** Portal on StarTrekTheCruise.com for more information.

GETTING TO PORT CANAVERAL, FLORIDA

Boarding on February 20, 2026, typically begins around 11:00 AM ET. When you complete your Online Check-In (45 Days prior to the sailing), you will select a Terminal Arrival Time. To avoid delays and congestion, PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE TO THE TERMINAL BEFORE YOUR SELECTED ARRIVAL TIME.

LEAVING FROM PORT CANAVERAL, FLORIDA

Once the ship arrives back to Port Canaveral, FL., on February 27, 2026, Customs and Border Patrol will perform an inspection. After the ship has been cleared, you will be allowed to disembark. Due to the time it takes to clear the ship, we recommend booking return flights after 12:00 PM ET on disembarkation day. Uber, Lyft, and taxi services are readily available and offer affordable transportation to nearby airports.

PURCHASE TRAVEL INSURANCE

Picture the *U.S.S. Enterprise* trapped in a time loop, colliding with another starship again and again, alarms blaring, systems failing, and the crew racing to fix the unthinkable. Travel insurance is your real-world deflector shield, protecting you from unexpected mishaps like medical emergencies, lost luggage, or delays, so your mission stays on course no matter what anomalies arise. Remember, your reservation payments are non-refundable. Though insurance may be purchased up to 48 hours prior to sailing, to secure the broadest coverage, insurance should be purchased as early as possible.

45 DAYS prior to the sailing (January 6, 2026), we will provide you with email instructions on how to complete Royal Caribbean's Online Check-In. Once your online check-in is complete, you can print your "Set Sail Pass", which acts as your boarding pass for Embarkation Day. If you do not complete your online check-in prior to the sailing, you may face substantial delays inside the cruise terminal on embarkation day.

30 DAYS prior to the sailing (January 21, 2026), we will provide you with email instructions on how to print your Royal Caribbean Luggage Tags. These tags should be affixed to all pieces of your luggage the morning of embarkation.



REGISTER FOR ACCESSIBLE SEATING

Guests with mobility issues may register to be seated in the accessible section, located in the rear of the Lyric Theatre, for each evening's Main Show. To register, visit the **Booked Guest** Portal on StarTrekTheCruise.com and click ACCESSIBLE CRUISING.
